Revision of Church Electoral Roll

This is the annual additions and removals revision. The collation of a new electoral roll occurs every 6 years and was last conducted in 2019. In the intervening years the roll is revised.

A form for addition or removal from the electoral roll will be available in the Abbey after the Sunday Eucharist on Sunday 24 March and Sunday 31 March, or please call into the Parish Office (Monday to Friday 9.30am to 12.45am).

The Revision will take place between 22 March and 5 April. All additions / removals must be received no later than 5 April. Only those on the Electoral Roll can attend the APCM, and stand for election to the PCC.

Just Building Bridges


We're delighted to welcome a new exhibition of photographs and short films into the Abbey on 3 April. Titled 'Just Building Bridges', the exhibition is the fruit of a series of photography workshops at the Hatton Gallery Learning Space.

The artists are from several different countries and continents, and have a wide range of backgrounds, experiences, and cultures. Some have lived in the area for many years, others were new arrivals. All of them are trying to 'build bridges' – to resettle peacefully and successfully in local communities.

The themes of the exhibition include local environmental issues of waste, litter, and noise; bigger economic issues such as the fast fashion industry; and some very topical issues of global significance are addressed, such as the conflicts in the Ukraine and the Middle East.
